
## Findlay Chalky's Wednesday Valley League Week One - Notes from the Officers 9/12/19

Reminder: When a new player plays for the first time this year, they owe \$41 for that week... \$15 for Valley sanction, \$15 for BCA sanction, \$2 for Compusport and \$2 for Indiana State tournament, plus the \$7 fee for the weekly match.
