Organizational meeting is **ONLY OPEN TO CAPTAINS, CO-CAPTAINS** (a representative of the team if the captain/co-captain cannot attend) **AND ANYONE WISHING TO PUT THEIR NAME IN FOR AN OFFICER OF THE LEAGUE**. Each team will only have 1 vote.

Starting Time/Night of play: Monday at 6:30 p.m. (real time) with a 15 minute grace period.

League is uncapped. League will play **everyone 1 time**.

Prize Fund: \$5.00 per player per week plus table quarters.

Sanction fee: \$15.00 due the first night of play. After November 30th the fee will be \$17.00. After March 31, 2020 the fee will be \$25.00. If sanction fees are not paid, the players are deemed illegal and their games will not count.

IAMOA fee: \$2.00 due the first night of play.

Compusport fee: \$3.00 due the first night of play.

- **SANCTION UPDATES** Please be sure that you are placing ALL VITAL INFORMATION ON THE TEAM ROSTER FORM

Sanction fees for VNEA and IAMOA are now a “once a year” fee. So, if you have already played in a VNEA league for the 2023-2024 season, you do not owe either of these sanctions because you have already paid those fees. If the league you played in is a Pioneer 2023-2024 season league, then you have already paid the COMPUSPORT fee as well. If the league you played in is “ANOTHER VENDOR’S” 2023-2024 league, then you will only owe the Compusport fee of \$3.00. ALL PAPERWORK MUST BE FILLED OUT IN COMPLETE DETAIL OR YOU MIGHT END UP PAYING A SECOND SANCTION. (I.e., if you call yourself Jimmy in one league, call yourself Jimmy in all leagues!!!)

- ❖ If you have NOT PLAYED in a 2023-2024 pool league at all, you will owe \$20.00 for sanctions/fees the first night of play. (This does NOT include league fees \$5 or table quarters)
- ❖ If you HAVE PLAYED in a 2023-2024 pool league NOT a Pioneer Vending league, you will still owe \$3.00 for Compusport fees. (You will also owe the \$5 league fees plus table quarters.)
- ❖ If you HAVE PLAYED in a 2023-2024 Pioneer Vending pool league you will owe nothing for sanctions/fees the first night of play. (You will still owe the \$5 league fees plus table quarters.)

Awards: 1st place: Sponsor and 5 individual plaques

2nd place: Same as 1st place

3rd place: Sponsor plaque

MVP Plaques: Male and Female with $\frac{3}{4}$ of the season. Highest average and highest ball count.

15 game round robin format. Players are to be positioned lowest to highest average. New players without an average must be placed in the 3rd position. If there are two (2) new players they are placed in the 2nd and 4th positions.

Handicap: Maximum of three (3) per player. This is figured out the first round and then carried out.

This league will carry over averages from last year for 4 weeks if you played at least 4 weeks last year. New players averages will be figured the first night of play and used to calculate handicap – they will not be carried over at all.

9-person Roster. You can add a player anytime to your roster without captain's approval as long as you do not exceed 8 players. After you reach 9 players, you need opposing team captain's approval if more than 24 hours prior to the match and tell the secretary of the approval and the player you intend to drop. If it is less than 24 hours, you need $\frac{3}{4}$ captains approval prior to the match.

A player can be dropped because of work and then picked back up on the same team.

NO NEW PLAYERS THE LAST FOUR (4) WEEKS.

If there is a bye, it will be **unpaid**

Protest fee is \$10.00 per VNEA rule book procedure. Protest must be filed and paid for the night of the issue and placed in pay envelope delivered to league secretary.

The team captain or team rep must attend each captain's meeting or lose 1 winning round point. The meetings will be at **6:00** p.m.

Drop off point: Eagles by **4:00** p.m. Tuesday. If late or incorrect, 1 winning round point deduction.

If a Ref is needed during a match, use neutral league captain when possible or opposing team captain.
