## NO ONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE EAGER BEAVER AXE HOLE AFTER 8 P.M. THE AXE HOLE IS CLOSED AT 10 P.M. ON SUNDAYS.

THIS LEAGUE WILL REQUIRE PATCHING OF THE 8-BALL POCKET.

THIS LEAGUE WILL REQUIRE THAT YOU PLAY WITH THE CUE BALL ON THE TABLE – THE ONE PROVIDED BY PIONEER VENDING.

Voting in this league will be limited to captains only. There must be a captain from a team present in order to vote. You cannot have someone else randomly vote for you.

League is uncapped to the capacity of the available locations.

Starting time and night of play: Sunday at 5:30 p.m. with a 15-minute grace period. At 5:45 LEAGUE IS TO BEGIN. If the opposing team is not present, they forfeit. If only part of the team is there, begin playing matches available. If the opposing team is still not present when the available matches for the first round are complete, then the remainder of the games are forfeited. EX., opposing team has 2 players present at 5:30. Play the two games for those two players in the first round. The next player must have arrived by the time those two are finished to go on. If there are 3 players present, the opposing team can choose to finish the match – all 3 rounds.

Prize Fund: \$5.00 per player per week plus table quarters.

Sanction fee: \$15.00 due the first night of play. After November 30<sup>th</sup> the fee will be \$17.00. After March 31, 2021 the fee will be \$25.00. If sanction fees are not paid, the players are deemed illegal and their games will not count.

IAMOA fee: \$2.00 due the first night of play.

Compusport fee: \$3.00 due the first night of play.

**AWARDS:** 

 $1^{st}$  PLACE: Sponsor plaque and individual plaques for 5 PLAYERS ONLY. If the team wants more they must pay for them

2<sup>nd</sup> PLACE: 10 or more teams – individual plaques (as above) and sponsor plaque

9 or less teams – sponsor plaque only

3<sup>rd</sup> PLACE: Sponsor's plaque

MVP PLAQUES: MALE AND FEMALE – Highest average. In order to qualify, a player must play 2/3 of the season. The season will consist of the number of games available for an individual to play. Bye week games will not be considered as games available to play.

You must play 2/3 of the season to qualify for awards. The season will consist of the total number of games available for an individual to play. Bye weeks will not be counted as playable games.

15 game round robin format. Players are to be positioned lowest to highest average. New players without an average must be placed in the 3<sup>rd</sup> position. If there are two (2) new players they are placed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> positions.

HANDICAP: 3 points per player, maximum of 15 per round.

The Sunday league will carry over averages from last season for the first 4 weeks of play. You must have played at least 4 weeks to carry over an average. New players entering the league will figure their averages that evening and put in the necessary handicap.

ROSTER: 10 players Maximum. Teams can add at will until they reach 10 players. After the roster is full, if the secretary is not notified about a player drop at least one week prior to the match, the roster is considered full and ¾ of the captains must contacted up until match time for approval of a new player. A player is not on a roster until they shoot.

## FLOATING SUBS will be allowed. But each sub MUST be willing if able to play for anyone.

NO NEW PLAYERS THE LAST FOUR (4) WEEKS.

If there is a BYE it will be a no-pay, no points week.

At Regional time, teams must try to work with each other to get their games played. If a team is still in the tournament on Sunday, the league games cannot be forfeited. If it is just one player, please try and use your subs.

Protest fee is \$10.00 per VNEA rule book procedure.

The team captain or team rep must attend each captain's meeting or lose 1 winning round point. The meetings will be at 4:30 p.m.

DROP OFF POINT: River's Edge by 7:00 p.m. Monday. Late or incorrect money will result in a 1 winning game point loss. If there is a problem getting your money in on time, please call Victor.

This league will pay for 2 state spots (If there are 10 or more teams) or 1 state spot (if there are 9 or fewer teams) - \$125.00 – green's fees not included. State spot will be used for either Ohio or Indiana. The first spot will be given to the highest placed team that intends to go to either state tournament. The second spot will be given to the next highest placed team that intends to go to either state tournament.

BAD WEATHER - PRESIDENT WILL CALL THE BARS BY 4:00 PM IF THE LEAGUE IS CANCELLED. If league is called off for weather then it will be a no pay-no play week. Schedule will not be pushed out.
