Everyone can vote during organizational meeting. After that any future meetings will be captains only vote.

Starting Time/Night of play: Thursday at 7:00 p.m. (real time) with a 15-minute grace period.

You must use the equipment provided by Pioneer Vending at the bar UNLESS agreed upon by BOTH TEAM CAPTAINS (AND SIGNED ON THE ORIGINAL SCORESHEET) BEFORE the match begins.

If you are waiting on a player – THE OPPOSING TEAM CAPTAIN must be notified and agrees to wait - not just one of the other players.

If someone requests playing their games out: must play first round all the way through and then the opposing team MUST allow the requesting player to play their next two games out. ***Player MUST vacate the premises within 30 minutes of the end of THEIR last game.

Prize Fund: \$5.00 per player per week plus table quarters.

Sanction fee: \$15.00 due the first night of play. After November 30th the fee will be \$17.00. After March 31, 2021 the fee will be \$25.00. If sanction fees are not paid, the players are deemed illegal and their games will not count.

IAMOA fee: \$2.00 due the first night of play.

Compusport fee: \$4.00 due the first night of play. (includes the \$1.00 scoring fee)

<u>League Payout will be based on rounds won.</u> PAYOUT: will be at the winning team bar.

AWARDS: 1st Place: sponsor's plaque and individuals for 5 individuals. Additional plaques may be purchased.

everyone that has played at least 5 weeks and is still on the roster.

2nd Place: Same

3rd place: Sponsor's plaque.

MVP Male and Female – must play ¾ of the physical games available to play – highest average first then

by most points.

\$300.00 limit on plagues.

FORMAT: 15 game round robin. You must position your players lowest to highest averages. If you bring in a new player (a player who does not have a carry-over average from last year), you must place him/her in the 3rd position. (Visiting team will be 8th position.) If you have more than 1 new player, they must play 2nd and 4th (visiting team 7th and 9th.)

Handicap: Maximum of three (3) per player. This is figured out the first round and then carried out.

League will carry over averages from last year. Any player that played a minimum of 5 weeks last year will carry over that average for the current season. The league will use last year's averages for the FIRST 3 WEEKS of league play if league consists of less than 20 weeks of play. The league will use last year's averages for the FIRST 4 WEEKS of league play if league consists of 20 or more weeks of play. After which, the secretary will assign each player the average they

shot the first 4 weeks of the league. New players entering the league or players that did not shoot the minimum game requirement last season will figure their averages the first night they shoot and figure handicaps that evening.

10 PLAYER ROSTER: Roster is open until the 10th player is added. After your roster is full, if the secretary is not contacted at least one week prior to the match with a player drop, the roster is still considered full, and ¾ of the captains must be contacted up until match time for approval of a new player. Players can be dropped and re-added on the same team for major illness and work related (shift change) reasons only.

This league uses a floating sub list. Floating subs will be required to follow the carry over averages rule as stated above. Floating subs will be permitted to play at 1 regional tournament with any team in their league that asks to pick them up. Floating subs will be required to play 4 weeks and 12 games to play at regionals.

NO NEW PLAYERS THE LAST FOUR (4) WEEKS <u>this includes floating subs</u>. (Players must be on your roster.) A roster player must have an average. (Must have played at least 1 week with your team.)

If there is a bye, it will be a no-pay, no-points night.

Protest fee is \$10.00 per VNEA rule book procedure (must be in writing).

The team captain or team rep must attend each captain's meeting or lose 1 winning round point. The meetings will be at 7:00 p.m.

DROP OFF POINT: River's Edge by 7:00 P.M. Friday. If late, you lose 1 round point.

The league will pay for 1 STATE SPOT @ \$200.00. Winning team may choose either Ohio or Indiana State tournament. The state spot will be given to the highest placing team that is attending either Ohio or Indiana State. If that team is already receiving money for state tournament from another Pioneer league, it will go to the next place team that is attending one of the tournaments. (The league secretary will to the best of his/her ability check into this.) This team must consist of players from this league (the majority of the team on the state roster) in order to qualify for this money.

If there is a cancellation due to weather it will be the responsibility of the league president to contact the bars and captains and inform them of the cancellation. If league is called off for weather then it will be a no pay-no play week. Schedule will not be pushed out.
