Everyone can vote during organizational meeting. After that any future meetings will be captains only vote.

Substitution rule: If one (1) player is unable to make a night's match due to illness, the opposing team will pick one (1) player name from the short team to play twice. The playing person's average will be used for determining handicap. ON THE SCORESHEET, please write "Playing person's name" is playing for "Missing person's name"

Starting Time/Night of play: Wednesday at 6:00 p.m. (real time) with a 15 minute grace period.

Prize Fund: \$5.00 per player per week plus table quarters.

Sanction fee: \$15.00 due the first night of play. After November 30th the fee will be \$17.00. After March 31, 2021 the fee will be \$25.00. If sanction fees are not paid, the players are deemed illegal and their games will not count.

IAMOA fee: \$2.00 due the first night of play.

Compusport fee: \$3.00 due the first night of play.

ADD \$2.00 FOR YOUR MVP AWARDS FIRST NIGHT ONLY (see below)

League Payout will be based on round points.

Awards: 1st place: Sponsor and 5 individual plagues

2nd place: Sponsor and 5 individual plaques

***It is up to the players on the team to decide if they want plagues or money.

MVP: There will be two (2) MVP plaques: one for men and one for women. Highest ball count vs. highest average. If there is a playoff, it will be as soon as possible at a neutral bar. Best 2 out of 3 games. The first night each player (5) will pay \$2.00 to go toward the MVP plaques. Any money left over after paying for the plaques will go to the MVPs.

You must play ¾ of the season to qualify for awards. The season will consist of the total number of games available for an individual to play. Bye weeks will not be counted as playable games.

15 game round robin format. Players are to be positioned lowest to highest average. New players without an average must be placed in the 3^{rd} position. If there are two (2) new players they are placed in the 2^{nd} and 4^{th} positions.

Handicap: Maximum of three (3) per player. This is figured out the first round and then carried out.

This league will have NO carry over averages. First night of play will be heads up.

8-person Roster. You can add a player anytime to your roster without captain's approval as long as you do not exceed 8 players. After you reach 8 players, you need opposing team captain's approval if more than 24 hours prior to the match and tell the secretary of the approval and the player you intend to drop. If it is less than 24 hours, you need ¾ captains approval prior to the match.

NO NEW PLAYERS THE LAST FOUR (4) WEEKS.

If there is a bye, it will be a no-pay, no-points night.

Protest fee is \$10.00 per VNEA rule book procedure.

The team captain or team rep must attend each captain's meeting or lose 1 winning round point. The meetings will be at 5:30 p.m.

Drop off point: Montpelier Eagles or Yesterday's by 6:00 p.m. Thursday. If late or incorrect, 1 winning round point deduction.

This league does not pay for a state spot.

If there is a cancellation due to weather it will be the responsibility of the league president to contact the bars and captains and inform them of the cancellation. The president will also contact captains by 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday to cancel.
