*****A captain's meeting was held and it was voted to ban Scott Burchfield from this league for life. (Vote: 11 for, 4 against, 1 not accounted for.)

Organizational meeting is open to all but vote is limited to captains only.

Starting Time/Night of play: Tuesday at **6:30 p.m.** (real time) with a 15 minute grace period.

This league is uncapped. Each year the number of weeks will be determined based on the number of teams. 2024-2025 season has an odd number of teams, so the season will consist of playing everyone twice.

League voted that YOU CAN use a template rack.

Prize Fund: \$5.00 per player per week plus table quarters.

Sanction fee: \$15.00 due the first night of play. After November 30th the fee will be \$17.00. After March 31, 2021 the fee will be \$25.00. If sanction fees are not paid, the players are deemed illegal and their games will not count.

IAMOA fee: \$2.00 due the first night of play.

Compusport fee: \$4.00 due the first night of play. (includes the \$1.00 scoring fee)

Awards: 1st place: \$150.00 and sponsor plaque

2nd place: \$100.00 and sponsor plaque

3rd place: \$50.00 and Sponsor plaque

MVP Plaques: Male and Female - Plaques for highest average and highest ball count.

***Must play $\frac{3}{4}$ of the season to be considered for MVP

15 game round robin format. Players are to be positioned lowest to highest average. New players without an average must be placed in the 3rd position. If there are two (2) new players they are placed in the 2nd and 4th positions.

Handicap: Maximum of two (2) per player. This is figured out the first round and then carried out.

This league will carry over averages from last year. Any player that played a minimum of 5 weeks last year will carry over that average for the current season. The league will use last year's averages for the first 4 weeks of league play, after which the player's average will be as figured with the Compusport program for this year's games played. New players this year and those that did not shoot the minimum game requirement last season will figure their averages the first night of play and used to calculate handicap.

8-man Roster. You can add a player anytime to your roster without captain's approval as long as you do not exceed 8 players. After you reach 8 players, you need opposing team captain's approval if more than 24 hours prior to the match and tell the treasurer of the approval and the player you intend to drop. If it is less than 24 hours, you need $\frac{3}{4}$ captains approval prior to the match.

Once a player has played for a team, he/she cannot switch to another team.

NO NEW PLAYERS THE LAST FOUR (4) WEEKS.

Protest fee is \$10.00 per VNEA rule book procedure.

Drop off point: The American Legion by 6:00 p.m. Wednesday. This is real time, not bar time. If late, HOME TEAM will lose 1 round point.

If there is a BYE it will be a no pay/no points week. These games WILL NOT count toward the number of weeks required to meet the $\frac{3}{4}$ of games played requirements.

If a team wants to move to another bar and wishes to retain their spot, they must have 3 original members from the previous season.

If there are blizzard/weather conditions it will be up to the league president to determine if there should be a cancellation due to weather. If league is called off for weather then it will be a no pay-no play week. Schedule will not be pushed out.

Payout will be at the 1st place team's bar – 3 weeks after last week of play.
