

For the 2026 Tournament, the lock date for CSRs will be February 3, 2026.

OCMA will be placing Open Players into 4 Levels (Masters, AA, A, B divisions) and Ladies Players will be placed in 3 Levels (Masters, AA, A divisions) based on their CSRs for the 2026 tournament.

Team Events (combined players' CSRs of the 5 highest players listed on the Canton roster – 4 highest for Ladies Teams)

M	CSR 9100 and over	(approximately 10-15% of the entries)
AA	CSR 8751-9099	(approximately 15-20% of the entries)
A	CSR 8151-8750	(approximately 50-55% of the entries)
B	CSR up to 8150	(approximately 20-25% of the entries)
LM	CSR 6401 and over	(approximately 15-20% of the entries)
LAA	CSR 6101-6400	(approximately 40-45% of the entries)
LA	CSR up to 6100	(approximately 40-45% of the entries)

Singles Events (individual players' CSRs)

SM	CSR 1851 and over	(approximately 10-15% of the entries)
SAA	CSR 1771-1850	(approximately 20-25% of the entries)
SA	CSR 1651-1770	(approximately 45-50% of the entries)
SB	CSR up to 1650	(approximately 15-25% of the entries)
SLM	CSR 1701 and over	(approximately 10-15% of the entries)
SLAA	CSR 1551-1700	(approximately 30-35% of the entries)
SLA	CSR up to 1550	(approximately 50-55% of the entries)

Just as VNEA has implemented, players without a qualified CSR would come into the OCMA Tournament at 1771 for Open and 1551 for Ladies.

In order to have a “Qualified CSR” the player must have a rating of 3.5 stars or higher OR a minimum of 12 leagues nights played on CompuSport. **The 12-night minimum (for all players, including subs, in one or more sessions) will need to be completed by March 17th.**

All players in both singles and teams must have at least 12 nights played, shown on CompuSport to be eligible to participate in Canton.

OCMA still requires 3 “Original team members (2 for Ladies teams)” in the Open A and Open B divisions. Just like in the past “All Star Teams” including players from your entire league system can be entered in the AA and Masters Divisions.
